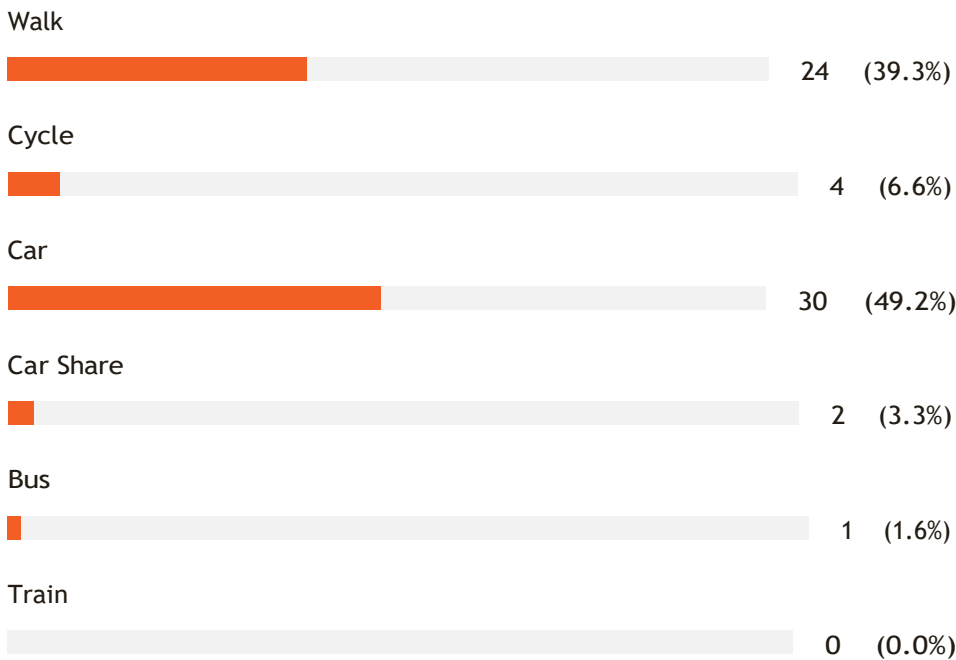

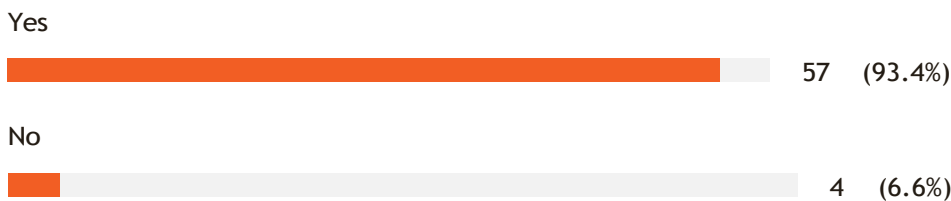
Question 1 has 61 answers (Radio Buttons)

“How did you travel to the Cathedral today?”



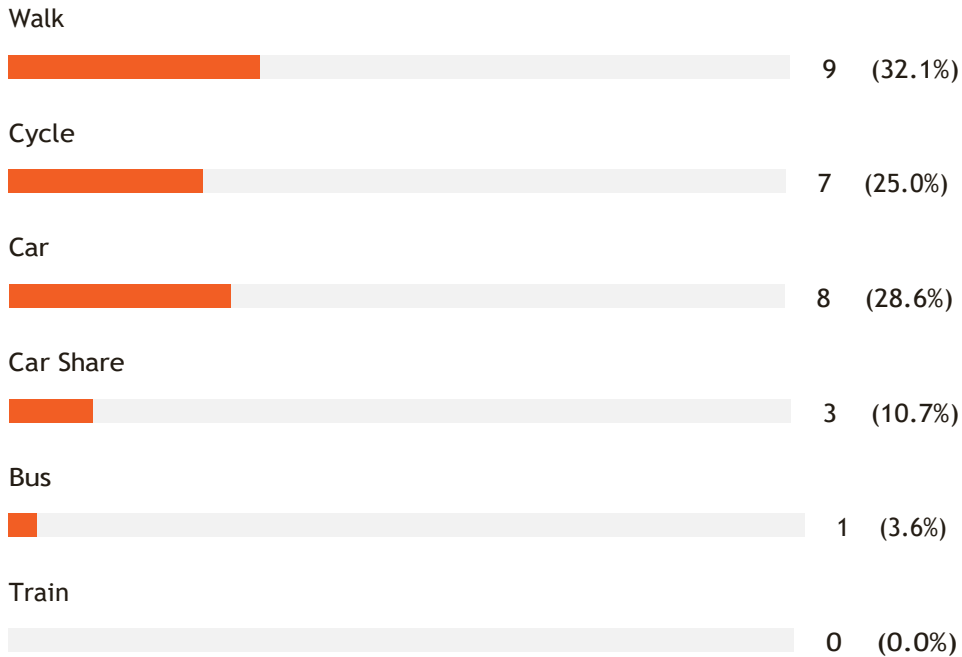
Question 2 has 61 answers (Radio Buttons)

“Is this your usual mode of travel to church?”



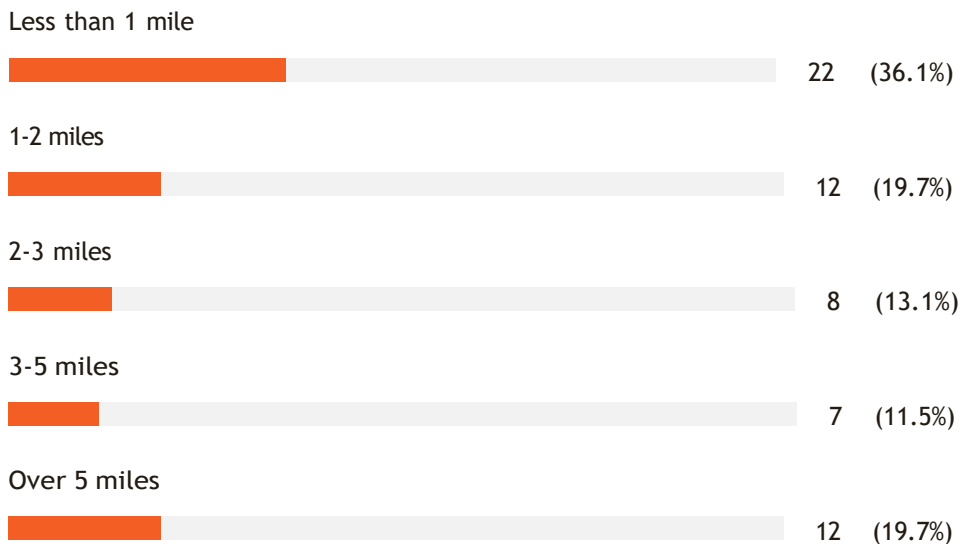
Question 3 has 28 answers (Radio Buttons)

“How far from the Cathedral is your home?”



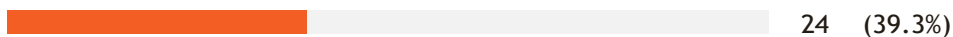



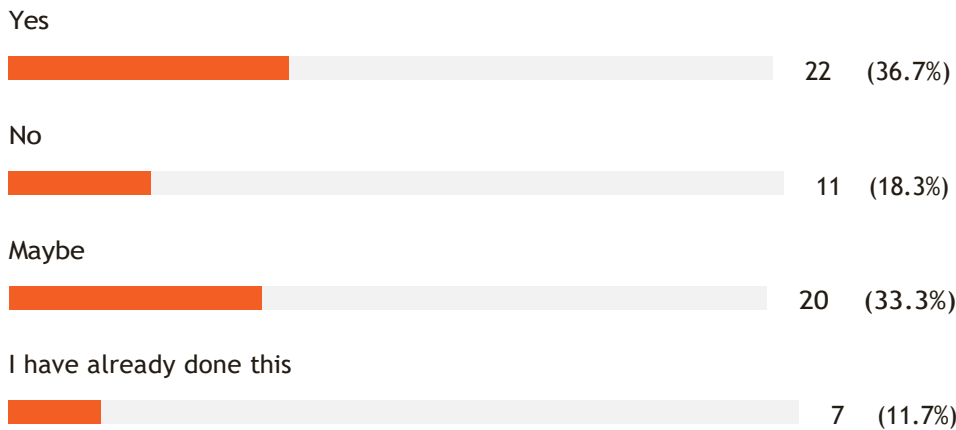
Question 11 has 58 answers (Radio Buttons)

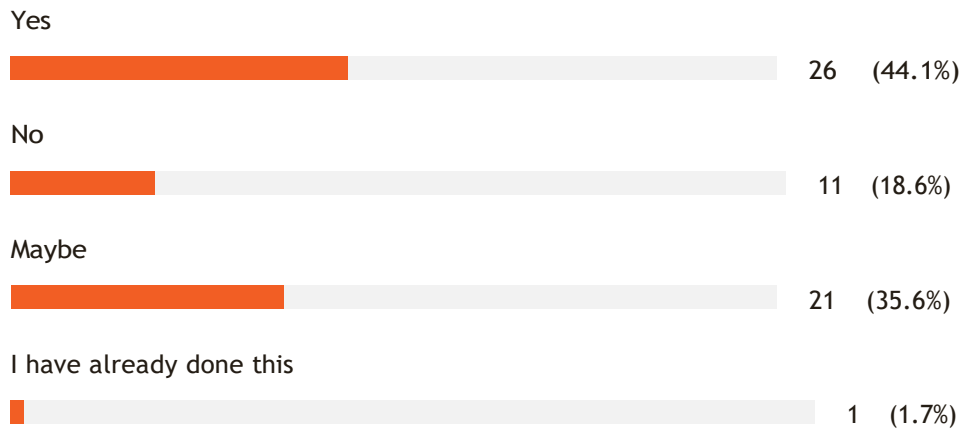
