Join us as we journey towards an EcoChurch Gold award... Llandaf Cathedral received the Silver award this week! We are eager to proceed to the next level. Each week we will update you on the progress we are making and highlighting ways that you can join with us to care for God's creation. St. David said *'Be joyful, keep the faith, and do the little things...'*. A little thing you can do this week:

Airdry your clothes! — Spring means more sunshine and longer days. Take advantage of this and air dry your clothes and textiles on the washing line, or on an airer with the windows open. Why? Machine drying clothes accounts for 75% of laundry's total carbon footprint, whereas air-drying your clothes as part of a sustainable laundry routine can help reduce climate impact by 67%. By drying our clothes outside, we also keep them fresh and free from musty smells. You get bonus points if you use bamboo pegs instead of plastic ones.
